EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 228 Series of 2020

“AN ORDER CONSTITUTING THE REVALIDA TEAM FOR THE SOCIAL PROGRAMS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN THE ISLAND GARDEN CITY OF SAMAL”

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared a State of Public Health Emergency and subsequently, a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease (COVID – 2019) in the country;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code mandates all local government units (LGU) to exercise the powers for the efficient and effective governance essential to uphold the general welfare, especially the health and safety of its people;

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, Republic Act 11469 known as the “Bayanihan to Heal as One Act” was enacted to mitigate transmission of Covid – 19;

WHEREAS, Section 4 (g) of Republic Act 11469 commands all LGU to act within the rules, regulations and directives issued by the National Government; further, Section 3 mandates the promotion and protection of the collective interests of all Filipinos in this challenging times;

WHEREAS, several cash-assistance programs were instituted by the different national agencies as aid to affected families and individuals in this time of national crisis;

WHEREAS, the Social Amelioration Program (SAP) is a cash emergency subsidy program (ESP) for 18 million Filipino families whose lives are greatly affected by the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ);

WHEREAS, the CoVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program (CAMP) is a safety net program that offers financial support to affected workers in private establishments that have adopted the Flexible Work Arrangements (FWAs) or temporary closure during the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, TUPAD or Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers is a community-based package of assistance that provides emergency employment for displaced workers, underemployed and seasonal workers, for a minimum period of 10 days, but not to exceed a maximum of 30 days, depending on the nature of work to be performed;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government has received about thousands of complaints against LGU officials on the irregularities in the distribution; such were forwarded to the Philippine National Police (PNP) which was ordered to conduct case build-up and filing of charges against erring local officials;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Duterte has offered Php 30,000 reward for every person who could give information about corrupt officials committing irregularities in the distribution of the cash assistance;

WHEREAS, there is a need to assist the national government in ensuring that the beneficiaries of the cash-assistance programs in the Island Garden City of Samal are bona fide to such programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, AL DAVID T. UY, City Mayor of the Island Garden City of Samal, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Creation. There shall be constituted a Revalida Team for all the social programs during the Covid-19 Pandemic in the Island Garden City of Samal. This shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson	: City Mayor
Co-Chairperson	: City Administrator
Vice-Chairperson	: City Accountant
Members	: City Legal Office
	City Social Welfare and Development Office
	City Mayor's Office – Public Employment Services Office
	City Treasurer's Office
	City Planning and Development Office
	City General Services Office

Section 2. Duties and Responsibilities. The Revalida Team shall be expected to:

- 2.1. Re-evaluate the list of beneficiaries of all social programs provided by the government.
- 2.2. Give recommendations as to actions to be taken based on the findings;
- 2.3. Perform other tasks as may be necessary in the achievement of the purpose of this Executive Order.

Section 3. The national and city government offices that lead the implementation of these social programs are directed to provide copies of payrolls and other pertinent documents for the revalidation process.


Section 4. Funding. The funding requirements shall be taken from the available funds of the City Government. Compensation may be collected in the form of honoraria as may be allowed by law, subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 5. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Order will be declared inconsistent or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby, shall continue in full force and effect

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All resolutions, memorandum orders, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced and in effect unless revoked.
