EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 241

Series of 2020

MODIFICATION IN THE ENTRY AND EXIT OF FERRY BOAT IN THE ISLAND GARDEN CITY OF SAMAL, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 240 (S. 2020)

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, a Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) strain was initially discovered in Wuhan, China on Dec. 31, 2019 which created a global havoc among nations including the Philippines resulting to Presidential Proclamation No. 992, "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines.;"

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 922 to put the country in a State of Public Health Emergency in relation to National Security;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (**IATF-MEID**) for COVID-19 provides for the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 235, Series of 2020 placed the entire Samal Island into Modified General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Order No. 240, Series of 2020, the city provide for limited operation guidelines on public sea transport and internet operations during Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) in the Island Garden City of Samal;

WHEREAS, the public sea transport of Island Garden City of Samal is operated by **Mae Wess Company, Incorporated** plying the route from Km 11, Sasa, Davao City to Babak, IGACOS and vice versa and **Dav-Sam Ferry Boat** plying the route from Panacan, Davao City to Babak, IGACOS and vice versa;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enforce limited operation guidelines to ease-out the implementation of the General Community Quarantine and impose strict measures for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, I, AL DAVID T. UY, City Mayor of the Island Garden City of Samal, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. Amendments to E.O. 240.

(a) Section 2 of E.O. 240 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. GUIDELINES ON FERRY BOAT AND LAUNCHES.

X x x

b. **Allowable activities.** The purpose of the travel must only for business, school, medical check-up, work and for other governmental transactions like paying tax and etc., subject, however, to the maximum 50% passenger capacity limit. The ferry boat captains must strictly observe the minimum health protocol under Section 3 hereof. Travel for leisure is still prohibited.

"Walk-in" passengers are allowed on board ferry boats during peak hours only.


Presentation of Quick Response (QR) Code and Valid Identification Card is a MUST.

SECTION 2. Unaffected Provisions. Unaffected provisions except for the above foregoing amendment, all other provisions of E.O. 240 shall remain in full force and effect;

SECTION 3. Repeal. All Executive issuances, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Order, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
